

This CFAC meeting was held to discuss the proposed back to work bonuses for Idaho employees.

Chairman Alex Adams called the meeting to order at 1:01pm. All members were present except for Chantel Greene.

Chairman Adams started the conversation on the back to work bonuses, stating their purpose and reviewing the documents provided for the meeting. These bonuses will be available for anyone that has filed for unemployment after March 1st and who have returned to work from May 1st and July 1st. The first wave of applications will be for employees who returned from May 1st to June 14th and the second for employees returning to work from June 15th to July 1st.

Trent Clark, the chairman of the Workforce Development Council, commented that he believes it addresses the "COVID bump" that Congress created. Joshua Whitworth, Matt Newton, and Dennis Johnson commented on their support of the proposal. Matt Newton moved to approve the proposal as presented with a second by Dennis Johnson. The motion passed 15-1 with Lt. Governor McGeachin voting nay.

Chairman Adams adjourned the meeting intending to meet next week to discuss further CFAC proposals.
