On December 14th, Idaho received its first shipment of the COVID-19 vaccine from Pfizer and Bio-n-Tech after the Federal Drug Administration recently authorized emergency use of the vaccine.

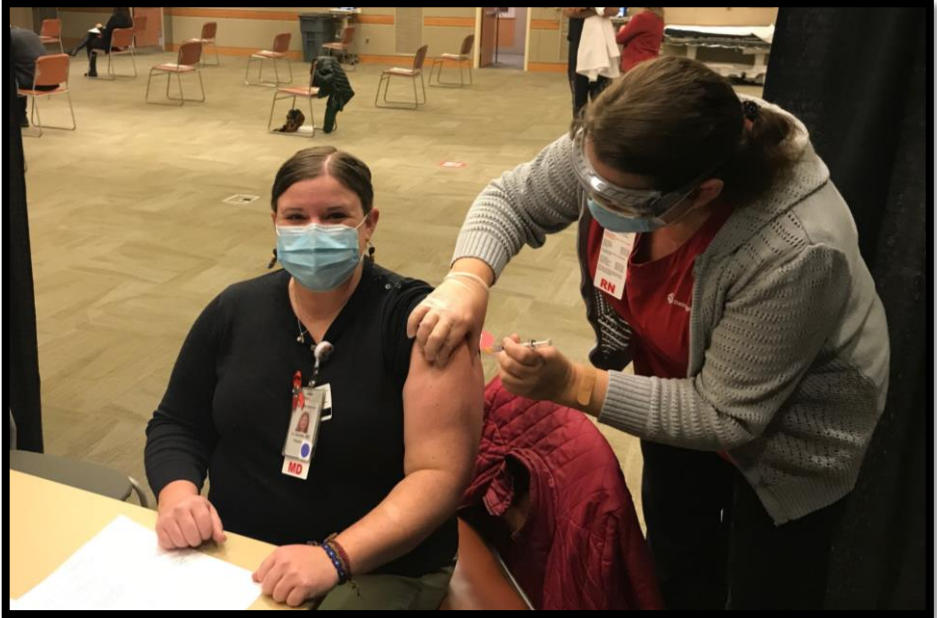
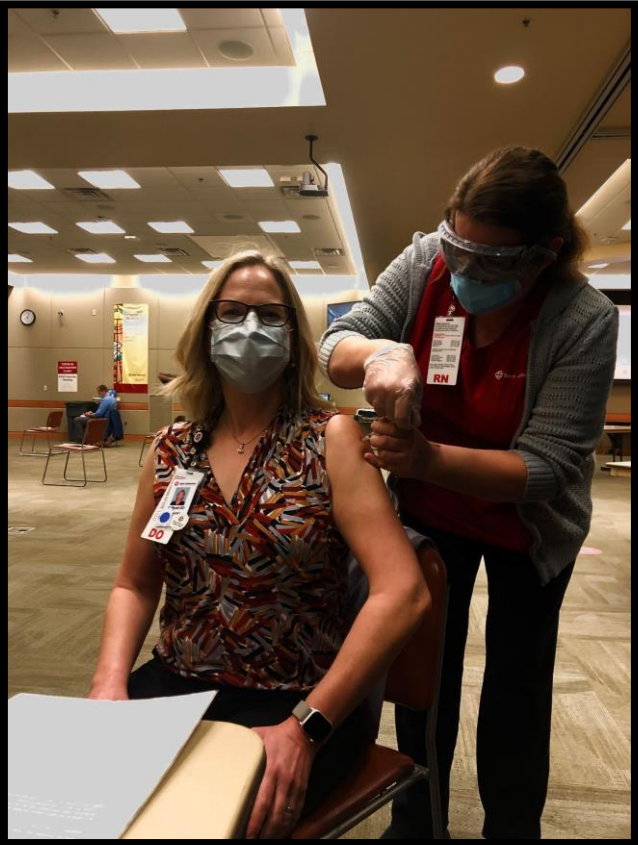
The state received 13,650 doses of the vaccine in this initial shipment according to the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare. The vaccine was sent from distributors to the Eastern Idaho Public Health District (EIPH), Saint Alphonsus, and St. Luke's.

Decisions that have been made

- CVAC agrees for Idaho to accept early distribution of vaccine at our existing ultra cold storage facilities
- CVAC sub-prioritized Healthcare Personnel and LTCF Group
- CVAC sub-prioritized Essential Workers Group
- CVAC recommended activation of the CDC Pharmacy LTCF Partnerships

Issues that still need to be addressed

- Clarification of Subgroup Prioritization & Vote (today's work)
- Anticipation of additional ACIP Guidance on Priority groups
- Further sub-prioritization of Essential Workers based on input
- Sub-prioritization of ACIP phase 1c and additional groups

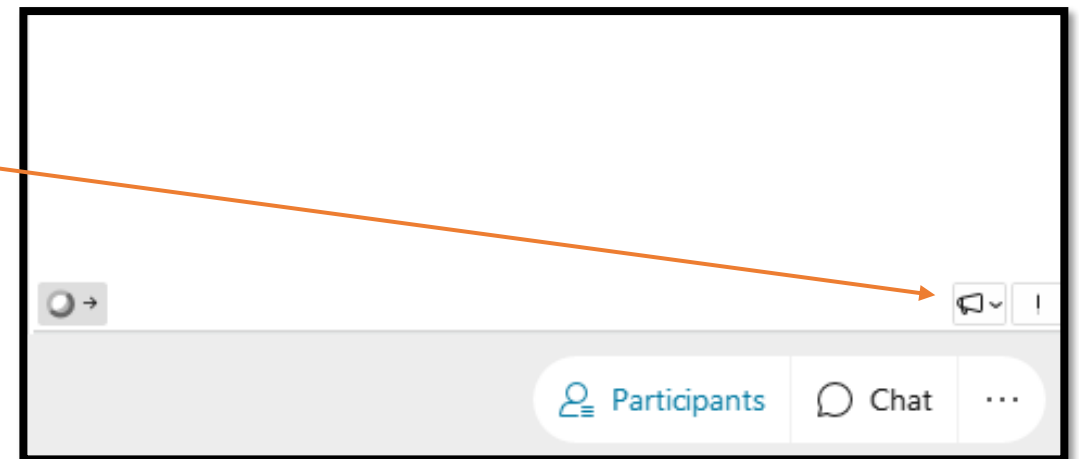
