

## February 1st

#### Focus

- 65+
- Managing high demand and limited vaccine
- Messaging
- Scheduling

### Challenges

- Process of scheduling that had been successful for other priority groups had flaws
- Successful 65+ kick off February 1st
  - 739 vaccinations given
    - 24 staff and volunteers/9 hours
  - Mostly 65+ population
  - Creative flow to assist physical distancing
  - Largest clinic since 2/1 EIPH vaccinated 1049 individuals

# New Process for scheduling


- EIPH had started a notification list in December
- February EIPH created and messaged a "wait list"
  - Included the prior notification list
  - Individuals were directed to sign-up (calling/online)
  - February 11, 2021
    - The combined notification and wait list "pulled"
    - Deduplicated and Sorted randomly
  - 10,000 individuals (after 3000 already scheduled/vaccinated)
    - Created staff script
      - Included confirmation appts for both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose
      - Prescreening
      - Process allowed spouse/partner to also schedule
    - Staff begin calling.......
  - February 12, 2021
    - Process change ☺
    - Call-em and Text-em all
  - February 18, 2021
    - 2/3 through list
    - Some counties current list is complete
    - Still having individuals submit to the wait list

## Eastern Idaho Public Health's COVID-19 Vaccine Waiting List for 65 & Older (After 2-10-2021)

In Idaho, people aged 65 and older became eligible to start receiving COVID-19 vaccinations beginning on February 1. *Vaccine supply continues to be extremely limited in Idaho and EIPH's eight-county health district* (Bonneville, Clark, Custer, Fremont, Jefferson, Lemhi, Madison, and Teton Counties). We are currently receiving approximately 2,500 doses of vaccine each week. The population of individuals aged 65+ in our health district is just over 30,000. As you can see, it may take up to 14 weeks for us to be able to serve everyone in this priority group who wishes to be vaccinated.

By completing and submitting this form, you will be placed on our waiting list for a COVID-19 vaccination appoinment. Eastern Idaho Public Health WILL CALL OR TEXT YOU (based on your selection below) between February 22-26 to let you know of your available appointment. Spouses will be allowed to schedule appointments together.
