# **Idaho COVID-19 Vaccine Program Goals**

- Reduce transmission, severe illness and death
- Preserve functioning of healthcare system
- Recover functioning of society and the economy
- Protect persons at risk who have access and functional needs
- Ensure equitable distribution within groups prioritized for vaccination phases and equity in the opportunity for health and well-being
- Ensure transparency regarding vaccine decision-making

## **Other Considerations:**

- Limited vaccine supply
- Epidemiologic data
- Logistics

### Frontline Essential Workers & Adults 65 Years of Age and Older

Frontline essential workers: workers who are in sectors essential to the functioning substantially higher risk of exposure to SARS-CoV2.

First responders (firefighters/police) and safety (protective services/community support)

- Coroners, medical examiners and mortuary and funeral service personnel
- Idaho Fish and Game and USDA law enforcement officers
- Adult and child protective services
- Child welfare workers
- Community food, housing, and relief services

Does CVAC vote to clarify that **FAA Airway Transportation System Specialists (ATSS)** be included in Group 2.1, First responders and safety?

(A 'no' vote indicates that FAA ATSS would be included in Idaho Group 3/ACIP Phase 1c.)
